Accessibility Information

VENUES

- All 3 of our main daytime venues – Site Gallery, Theatre Deli and S1 Artspace – are fully accessible with accessible toilets.
- All summit venues are wheelchair accessible. More detailed accessibility information about all venues is available on request.
- All venues are listed on our website <https://www.socialartsummit.com/venues/> and a map is also provided, with all venues marked. A physical fold-out map will also be available at the registration point, with distances marked.
- All venues are close to each other and close to the train station. The greatest distance from venue to venue is 1 mile (or 20 minutes average walking speed) between Theatre Deli and S1 Artspace. The exception to this is Tinsley Tingas.
- Front-of-house staff and summit volunteers will be on-hand to support.
